FLEDGE is currently working on supporting dialogue and discussions in shaping the future global biodiversity goals (2021-2030) in partnership with agencies like the United Nations Environment (UNEP), the UNEP-World Conservation Monitoring Centre, McGill University, the Secretariat to Convention on Biological Diversity and others.

Additionally, trade and conservation policy making is a focal area where FLEDGE is focusing on ensuring appropriate trade and development policies that consider the value of biological resources and deciding on appropriate pricing mechanism.

Working with a number of Government agencies in countries like Finland, Ethiopia and India, FLEDGE is currently supporting strengthening of focus on sustainable use and harvesting of biological resources for local development as well as moving forward the third objective of the Convention on Biological Diversity.
